Praise Report on Africa Prays

Paul Taiwo, ANU, Executive Director, welcomed all present to thank God and intercede for Africa. He then gave us the opening prayer, inviting the Holy Spirit into our midst. Pastor Niyi Adams led us thru a powerful time of Praise and Worship.

Pastor Paul Ulebor of Word of God Ministries, Badagry, Nigeria, encouraged us to be fervent in prayer and praise always, saying where prayer cannot go, praise will penetrate. He said ANU's vision will go around the world in a few years by the grace of God. He said, when God gives a vision, he makes provision in abundance. Pastor Paul read the supporting scripture for Africa Prays from [2Chron 7:14](#), repeating the last line...*and I will heal their land*.
