Africa Prays 2nd Annv. Celebration - Praise Report

After a short opening prayer, the Hope Christian Church Youth Group, Triple N Gen led by their Director, Minister Stan Spotswood started us off with an awesome time of Praise Worship and thanksgiving for what God is doing in Africa and beyond. Pastor Niyi Adams group followed with captivating arrays of praise songs.

A word of exhortation by Rev. Paul Taiwo followed. Reading from Habakkuk 2: 2-3, encouraged all to be fervent in prayer and that at the appointed time God's healing grace upon Africa will manifest and be complete.
